SYSAV RECYCLES WITH CMT

Sysav is responsible for waste management and recycling in the southern part of the county of Skåne in Sweden.

“We handle and sort untreated as well as dangerous waste from households and small industries at 16 recycling centres in southernmost Sweden,” says Rickard Frank, who is in charge of containers at Sysav.

In 2017, Sysav asked a number of suppliers to tender for the supply of containers. CMT won the contract which included an order for 51 containers with double-opening covers for their various recycling centres.

“The double-opening covers are perfect because they give us much more flexibility. You don't have to think about whether they are left or right opening and therefore specific to a particular recycling centre. As they open both sides, we can allocate the containers wherever they're needed,” says Rickard Frank.

The flexible solution was a first for Sysav. There were a few teething problems with the hydraulics for the covers but we worked together with Sysav to quickly solve the issues.

“I must say that CMT were quick to respond and make the necessary adjustments to get things working properly. A great level of service and full commitment.”

Another feature that Richard Frank appreciates is the use of curved sides and reinforced edges that replace other strengthening features. They have helped to improve aerodynamics and reduce fuel consumption.
